- Should have attained minimum age of 17 years as on 31st December of the year of Admission.
- Should have passed 10+2 exam from a recognized board in India or abroad with Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English as subjects.
- Should have obtained minimum 55% of marks average in PCB.

- After Completion of MBBS from Kyrgyz Republic, you have to appear for a “Screening Test” conducted by National Board of Education”, New Delhi.
- On clearing this test you need to register with the MCI and you will get a registration Number to practice in India or apply for Govt. Jobs or P.G. Courses in Govt. Medical Colleges in India.

4. How Parents Will Call Students?

- Students are advised to keep a mobile phone. Mobile phone system is highly developed in Kyrgyzstan. Incoming is totally free and parents can easily contact students. In addition to this, there is a common phone in hostel and students can be contacted.

5. Can My Parents Visit Me? Can I Travel in Holidays Or Stay Back?

- Parents / friends / relatives of students can visit the students. Tourist Invitations can be issued. For holidays, students can stay back in Kyrgyzstan or come back to India. Usually students' come back after the 1st year. In the 2nd year, some stay back and do local travel, some come to India.

- The vegetable available there are very similar to what we get here in India. All the popular vegetables like potato, brinjal, cauliflower, cabbage, beans, carrots, cucumber etc are available.
